Overview:

On June 20, 2013, SB 1374 was signed into law by Governor Jan Brewer. HB1374: Board of Behavioral Health Examiners Statutory Changes and Continuation of the Board, includes some dramatic changes. This piece of legislation significantly alters some of the laws governing our professions, along with the structure of the BBHE (Board of Behavioral Health Examiners). These changes will occur as early as September 2013 and continue for the next couple of years.
